- Susie Ganch noted the latest issue of the TSGS Stirpes contains an advertisement for the BAGS Dana Leeds September Seminar. Also noted that TSGS gives college scholarships.

Membership Policy and Bylaw Changes: George reviewed the proposed changes to membership policy and Bylaw changes. He noted this is the first time since the Society was formed that the due fee has been raised. Bill Mayo offered a change the wording in Membership policy, 2nd paragraph, 2nd sentence begins with "New Members who join..." to be "Effective 1 July 2019, new members who join..." Bob Wegner and Olieta Teas made 1st and 2nd the motions respectively. The group approved unanimously. Jeanine Lawrence asked the amounts assigned to each category: Contributor - \$5-\$29, Benefactor - \$30-\$49, Patron - \$50-

\$599, Lifetime membership - \$600 or higher. Group unanimously passed both the membership policy and bylaw changes.

Program: Susie Ganch, 2nd VP for Programs, introduced the speaker Kevin Kinney, Archivist at Galveston and Texas History Center (GTHC) located in Rosenberg Library, Galveston, TX. The handout, seven pages listing collection materials, was emailed to BAGS members prior to the meeting. Kevin noted that Rosenberg Library is celebrating 115 birthday after opening in 1904. This library is now a Family History Center affiliate. There is ongoing work to digitize the GTHC materials by volunteers. They are looking for reliable volunteers to help with the scanning. Kevin discussed what materials are found in the vertical files and manuscript collections. There are tax records from 1870s, school records from 1890s, and Galveston Insurance Board and property deed records.
