Clayton Library's New Internet Death Records Database

Clayton Library houses the records of two Houston funeral homes. The Fogle-West Funeral Home (Fogle West Undertaking Company) and the Boulevard Funeral Home (Boulevard Undertaking Company). Information that can be found in funeral home records is: last name, first name, middle name, nicknames, sex, age, death date, parents, place interred, copy of a death certificate, an obituary, information on an autopsy, last residence, insurance records, military service information, and potentially other details about a person's life.

A free Internet database is now available to search the indexes to these records, access:

www.houstonlibrary.org/cgi-bin/clayton/death recordspl

Search by a death date range, last name, or first and middle name. In the search results, click on the death date to get retrieval information you need to locate the original record at the library.


Thursday September 13, 2007 starting at 2:00 pm in Clayton Library
