Friday, July 31, 2015: Mike McCown presents "Utilizing Your DNA Test Results"

We meet at the University Baptist Church in the Great Room on the 2nd floor (16106 Middlebrook Drive, Houston, TX 77059 - online map).

BAGS charter member, Michael "Mike" DeWitt McCown has participated in the Family Finder, Y-DNA 111 markers, and mtDNA tests offered by FamilyTree DNA. In this program, Mike will review and interpret the results generated by each of these three tests. The results can be used to 1) connect with other living relatives that have also participated in the same DNA test 2) identify common ancestors, and 3) use common ancestor information to uncover family information at search sites like Ancestry.com and FamilySearch.org. Mike will be using the computer and Internet to interactively access the test results, demonstrate how to use the FamilyTree DNA interface, and locate information that you can plug into a search site. Mike is a military veteran, retired from his professional career, and currently serves as the Society's Sergeant-at-Arms.
