

BAGS Members Meeting Friday, <u>November 17th, 2023</u> at 7:00pm How to Find Your Ancestors in Church Records Speaker — Sunny Morton (Zoom)

Records created by the major Christian denominations before 1900 in the United States are an underutilized resource for family historians. In these records, you can find ancestors' births, maiden or married names, marriage details, deaths, family relationships, other residences, and even immigrants' overseas birthplaces. You may uncover information about ancestors who have been unnamed in other records – women, children, ethnic minorities, immigrants, and the poor. You might even find details about your ancestors recorded long before the existence of civil records!

Sunny Jane Morton is an internationally known genealogy speaker, award-winning writer, and editor. She is a contributing editor at Family Tree Magazine, contributing editor and content manager for <u>YourDNAGuide.com</u>, a contributor to <u>FamilySearch's blog</u>, and past editor of Ohio Genealogy News. She's received awards from the National Genealogical Society, most recently for her book *How to Find Your Family History in U.S. Church Records*, co-authored with Harold Henderson. Her book, *Story of My Life: A Workbook for Preserving Your Legacy*, is now in its 2nd edition.
