BAGS needs a new County Coordinator! This is a FUN position that doesn't require a lot of time, outside of the bus trip to Clayton Library and minimal time spent planning. The County Coordinator typically schedules only 4-6 bus trips per year. Two BAGS members currently serve as a backup and assist the County Coordinator as needed.

The County Coordinator:

- Works with Harris County and the backup coordinators to schedule each bus trip.
- Communicates upcoming dates to the board for publications.
- Tracks attending members count. <u>A minimum of ten attendees</u> <u>are required to meet Harris County guidelines for bus usage.</u>
- Sends reminders to attendees.
- Maintains policy agreement and emergency forms for all attendees.
- Takes attendance (at the beginning and end of the trip) to ensure all attendees are accounted for.

Each participant brings a unique perspective and knowledge to the group and everyone can help attendees with genealogy research as they feel comfortable. 
