BAGS needs a new County Coordinator! This is a FUN position that doesn't require a lot of time, outside of the bus trip to Clayton Library and minimal time spent planning. The County Coordinator typically schedules only 4-6 bus trips per year. Two BAGS members currently serve as a backup and assist the County Coordinator as needed.

### The County Coordinator:

- Works with Harris County and the backup coordinators to schedule each bus trip.
- Communicates upcoming dates to the board for publications.
- Tracks attending members count. **A minimum of ten attendees are required to meet Harris County guidelines for bus usage.**
- Sends reminders to attendees.
- Maintains policy agreement and emergency forms for all attendees.
- Takes attendance (at the beginning and end of the trip) to ensure all attendees are accounted for.

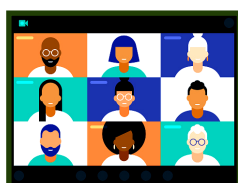

## Irish Genealogy

*May the records rise to meet you!*

Thirty-six million Americans have Irish ancestry, according to the 2008 US Census. That's almost nine times the population of Ireland, which has 4.1 million people.

The Irish flag is green, white, and orange. Green symbolizes the people of the south, and orange symbolizes the people of the north. White represents the peace that brings them together as a nation.

**St. Patrick's Day is observed on March 17** because that is the feast day of St. Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland. He is believed to have died on March 17, 461 AD. It is also a worldwide celebration of Irish culture and history. St. Patrick's Day is a national holiday in Ireland.

**St. Patrick** was born in 385AD somewhere along the west coast of Britain. At age 16, he was captured and sold into slavery to a sheep farmer. He escaped when he was 22 and spent 12 years in a monastery. In his 30s, he returned to Ireland as a Christian missionary. According to legend, St. Patrick drove the snakes out of Ireland. He died at Saul in 461 AD and is buried at Downpatrick.

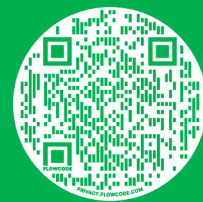
