
Family Tree Maker - by Appointment Only

NGS GenTech Insight Series: Navigating the AI Frontier Launches December 10th!

Join the National Genealogical Society (NGS) for Navigating the AI Frontier: AI's Impact on Genealogy on Wednesday, December 10. 2025, at 8:00 p.m. ET. This is the first event in a new series created by Steve Little, presented in partnership with NGS, that will help you stay up-to-date on artificial intelligence (AI). Sign up now via Zoom.

In the free ninety-minute live session, you'll learn about the latest AI developments and their potential use or challenges for the family history community. Little and a panel of experts in the field will guide you through the ever-changing AI universe.

Little is the AI Program Director for NGS, founder of AI Genealogy Insights, co-host of The Family History AI Show podcast, and co-founder of Family History AI Show Academy. With a background in applied linguistics, NLP, and archives, he specializes in AI and genetic genealogy, especially endogamy and complex relationships. He leads Navigating the AI Frontier, his standards-first symposium and NGS GenTech Insight series, which examines AI's uneven impact across genealogical specialties.











<u>HPL Clayton Library for Genealogical Research FamilySearch Center</u> <u>and Clayton Library Friends (CLF) Events</u>
